- All breeding pigs on the holding to be tagged with a tag showing the herd registration number and an individual number.

Recall of Irish Pork and Bacon Product

The Government today announced that laboratory results of animal feed and pork fat samples obtained this afternoon by the Food Safety Authority of Ireland (FSAI) confirmed the presence of dioxins.

Consequently, the FSAI is requiring the food industry to recall from the market all Irish pork products produced from pigs slaughtered in Ireland.

This recall involves retailers, the hospitality sector and the Irish pig processing sector. Preliminary evidence indicates that the contamination problem is likely to have started in September 2008.

The FSAI is advising consumers, as a precautionary measure, not to consume Irish pork and bacon products at this time. Investigations involving the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (DAFF) and the FSAI are continuing to determine the extent of the contamination and to identify the processors and products involved.

The FSAI and DAFF will provide updates as information becomes available.

Note for Editors

Dioxins are environmental contaminants that may be formed during combustion processes and may be present in industrial wastes. It is illegal for dioxins at certain levels to be in food products.

Pig meat traceability scheme not working



Ireland A report on the dioxin contamination of Irish pork in December 2008 found that the current pig meat traceability system is not working and an improved method should be vigorously pursued. The report from Joint Oireachtas Committee on Agriculture criticised the traceability system in place in December last when Ireland's total pork output was recalled.

An effective traceability scheme would have prevented all pork being recalled, said the report, urging processors to set up a pilot programme to give full traceability at factory level. The committee has called for the setting-up of a single agency for food as well as animal feed. It says that a full traceability of batches at slaughter should be introduced.

"Less than 10% of pork products were potentially affected by the contaminated feed. However, because

of the absence of a forensic traceability regime, 100% of products had to be recalled. This is likely to cost the Irish taxpayer hundreds of millions in compensation payouts," said Deputy Johnny Brady, the committee chairman.
