

This corrective action plan describes audit findings requiring corrective action, documents responsibility for addressing the findings and describes progress on the close-out of actions.

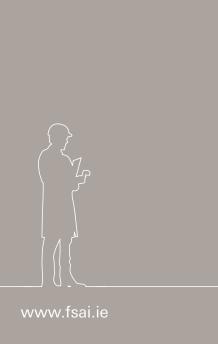
