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FOODSTUFFS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2013

I, JAMES REILLY, Minister for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972) and for the purpose of giving further effect to Commission Regulation (EU) No. 1058/2012 of 12 November 2012<sup>1</sup> hereby make the following regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Certain Contaminants in Foodstuffs) (Amendment) Regulations 2013.

2. In these Regulations—

“Principal Regulations” means the European Communities (Certain Contaminants in Foodstuffs) Regulations 2010 (S.I. No. 218 of 2010).

3. The Principal Regulations are amended—

(a) in Regulation 2(1), by substituting for the definition of “Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1881/2006” the following—

“‘Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1881/2006’ means Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1881/2006 of 19 December 2006<sup>2</sup> regarding setting maximum levels for certain contaminants in foodstuffs, as amended by Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1126/2007 of 28 September 2007<sup>3</sup>, Commission Regulation (EC) No. 565/2008 of 18 June 2008<sup>4</sup>, Commission Regulation (EC) No. 629/2008 of 2 July 2008<sup>5</sup>, Commission Regulation (EU) No. 105/2010 of 5 February 2010<sup>6</sup>, Commission Regulation (EU) No. 165/2010 of 26 February 2010<sup>7</sup>, Commission Regulation (EU) No. 420/2011 of 29 April 2011<sup>8</sup> as affected by Corrigendum to Commission Regulation (EU) No. 420/2011 of 29 April 2011<sup>9</sup>, Commission Regulation (EU) No. 835/2011 of 19 August 2011<sup>10</sup>, Commission Regulation (EU) No. 1258/2011 of 2 December 2011<sup>11</sup>, Commission Regulation (EU) No. 1259/2011 of 2 December

- (c) in Regulation 6(1), by substituting the following—

“For the purposes of this Regulation and of Regulations 7 to 11, all references to “the Annex” mean the Annex to Commission Regulation

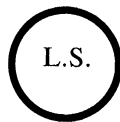

These Regulations give effect Commission Regulation (EU) No. 1058/2012 of 12 November 2012 amending Regulation (EC) No. 1881/2006 as regards maximum levels for aflatoxins in dried figs.

These Regulations amend the European Communities (Certain Contaminants in Foodstuffs) Regulations 2010 (S.I. No. 218 of 2010) in the manner specified in these Regulations.

These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Certain Contaminants in Foodstuffs) (Amendment) Regulations 2013.

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
